## About University

Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (RAJUVAS), Bikaner established on 13<sup>th</sup> may 2010. The University is located in heritage and palatial buildings of erstwhile Ganga Avenue housing the College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner (Since 1954) and its precincts, spreading over 200 acres of land. The University has sophisticated equipments and well-equipped facilities for the execution of the major three organs of the University, i.e., Teaching, Research, and Extension. The university covers entire Rajasthan state with 26 institutions including three veterinary colleges, 9 livestock research station (LRS) and 14 Pashu Vigyan Kendra (PVK). RAJUVAS has also provided free indigenous cattle calves to the Gaushalas and to progressive cattle breeders of state. The university is also pursuing its effort to execute state specific research through state sponsored 10 centers of advance research for benefits of livestock owners, students and researchers.

## About Centre

Centre for Studies on Wildlife Management and Health was established as State Plan Centre in 2012 with a mandate to work as knowledge centre for wildlife protection and propagation and to design strategies for protection of endangered species of wildlife. The centre provide technical support for health management of free and captive wildlife to facilitate their conservation and better health management, human resource development by capacity building to produce well trained and skilled manpower for the better management of wildlife resources in a healthy and sustainable way and enhancing productivity of ecosystems. The centre is also involved in monitoring of health and disease surveillance in captive and free range wild animals and birds, diagnosis and treatment of fatal diseases in wild animals and birds, conducting post mortem and laboratory procedures. The centre is also engaged in capacity building of veterinary students, veterinarians and personnel from State Forest department by organising trainings and workshops and promoting wildlife research.
