INSTRUCTIONS FOR NRI/NRI SPONSORED CANDIDATES

- The Candidate must ensure his/her eligibility (from the Information booklet) before filling up the form.
- 2. The candidate must submit online application after paying the prescribed fee US \$100. All the necessary documents must be scanned and uploaded with the online application. The candidate is required to present the hard copy of the submitted application form and the original certificates/testimonials at the time of counselling.
- 3. Latest passport size photograph duly signed by the candidate should be pasted in the space provided on the application form. This photograph should be similar in all respects as the candidate wishes to appear in the counselling. For example, if the candidate wishes to appear with beard, turban etc., thephotograph should appear so.
- 4. The application form must be completed and no column should be left blank. Write "not applicable" where no information is required to be given. Incomplete application form is liable to be rejected.
- 5. Information at Sr. No. 6 must be filled, otherwise, the application form will be considered incompleteand rejected.
- 6. Self attested copies of all the certificate from matriculation onwards and other supporting testimonialsmust be uploaded with the application form in the first instance.
- 7. Requisite fee of US\$100 or equivalent in Indian Currency must be deposited while submitting application form (Online payment mode), otherwise, the form will be rejected.
- 8. The University may, at his discretion, cancel the admission of a candidate if at any time, it is found thatthe candidate obtained the admission by misrepresentation/concealment of facts, or the admission wasmade due to error, oversight, etc.
- 9. Number of NRI and NRI sponsored seats- Five seats of BVSc & AH degree course in each of the constituent college (CVAS, Bikaner, PGIVER, Jaipur and CVAS, Navania, Udaipur) of RAJUVAS, Bikaner will be filled under NRI/NRI sponsored quota.

10. <u>Eligibility for NRI (Non- Residential Indian)/NRI sponsored</u> candidates-

Following will be the guidelines applicable for the admission in Under Graduate courses under NRI/NRI sponsored quota in all constituent colleges of RAJUVAS.

- 1. At least one of the parents of student should be an NRI and shall ordinarily be residing abroad as an NRI; or
- 2. The person who sponsors a student for admission should be a first degree relative of the student (i.e. real Brother/real Sister) and should be ordinarily residing abroad as an NRI; or
- 3. If student is taken as a ward by some other nearest relative [as mentioned below (i) to (v)] such students may also be considered for admission provided the guardian has bonafidely related the student as a ward. For this following nearest relative (NRI) of candidate, who should be ordinarily residing abroad as an NRI can only be considered:
 - i) Real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle real aunt.
 - ii) Real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt.
 - iii) Father and mother of father i.e. grandfather and grandmother.
 - iv) Father and mother *i.e.* maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother.
 - v) First degree- paternal and maternal cousins.
- 4. All NRI candidates shall submit a proof being sponsor as NRI/OCI/PIO in the form of certificate issued by the Indian embassy/Ministry of external affairs, Government of India for this purpose. In the absence of that certificate a duly notarized undertaking executed by the sponsor and notarized by the Notary Public of the foreign country where the sponsor resides being submitted

- by the sponsor, it be treated as sufficient as to the factum of the residence of the sponsor.
- 5. An affidavit from the sponsor that he/she looks after such student and will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate.

Reservation for NRI/NRI sponsored Quota

- (a) No reservation of any category will apply on NRI/NRI sponsored seats in any of the constituent colleges.
- (b) For admission under NRI Quota, priority will be given to the NRI with ancestral background of the State of Rajasthan by own/parents/Grandparents resided in State of Rajasthan at least for a period of 5 years at any time.
- (c) The proof of residence will also be applicable for the consideration priority for NRI Quota, for which document (Electricity/ Water bill/ Documents of immovable property/ Indian Passport/ Ration Card/ Voter ID/ Aadhaar Card etc.) to the effect for this criteria is required to be submitted by ward of NRI (including PIO/OCI).
- (d) Firstly, allotments of NRI Quota seats shall be allotted to candidate having ancestral background of the State of Rajasthan by own/parents/Grandparents resided in State of Rajasthan at least for a period of 5 years. Later on, remaining Vacant NRI seats will be allotted/filled by the candidates of NRI belonging to other states.
- (e) For PIO/OCI: Overseas Citizens of India (OCI), Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) are allowed for admission under NRI Quota.
- (f) Unfilled seat(s) of NRI/NRI sponsored category shall be treated un-reserved (Payment) and shall be filled as per university procedure.

Fee structure-

- 1. Fee for Application Form- 100 USD or equivalent in Indian currency should be payable on the day of filing of application.
- 2. Security/Caution Money- 2000 USD (Refundable) One time
- 3. Tuition Fee- 10000 USD per year for first three years (Non-refundable). The fee for 4th professional year will be 15000 USD (Non-refundable) as the 4th professional year is of one and half year duration while the first three professional years are of one year duration.
- Hostel Fee- 1200 USD per year and for forth professional year the hostel fees will be 1800 USD.

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission in BVSc & AH degree programme against NRI/NRI sponsored seats. The candidate must fulfil following criteria-

- 1. NRI candidates are such persons who do not reside in India and who are Non-Resident Indians (residing abroad).
- 2. The NRI/OCI/NRI sponsored candidates seeking admission to undergraduate programmes are not required to appear in NEET (UG)/RPVT 2022 or any other entrance test.
- 3. Candidates must have passed 10+2 standard or equivalent level examination with a minimum of 50% marks in individual subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English.
- 4. The eligibility of qualification will be subject to verification of equivalence with the 10+2 examination of any recognized Education Board of India.
- 5. The candidates must furnish the details of subjects studied, grades and percentage equivalent marks in the relevant columns of NRI/OCI/NRI sponsored application form.
- 6. Mere submission of the application does not guarantee admission to the programme.
- 7. Provide duly attested conversion formula from OGPA/OCPA to percentage (%).
