The 19th meeting of the Academic Council was held on 30.09.2021 at 10.30 AM in the Meeting Hall of VC Secretariat, RAJUVAS, Bikaner in hybrid mode under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. Satish K. Garg.

Thus, most of the times, students approach the Hon'ble High Court to seek justice. The house was of the opinion that vacant and management quota seats in B.V.Sc. & A.H. and AHDP should be filled up through a transparent policy by properly advertising the number of vacant seats in different academic programmes, inviting applications and then taking admission. It will reduce the possibility of unnecessary legal cases. It was resolved that a letter may be sent to VCI also regarding clear guidelines for filling up of vacant VCI seats of B.V.Sc & A.H. For AHDP admissions, also, it was resolved that after two online counsellings, more online/offline counsellings may be conducted by University to fill the vacant seats after approval from Govt. of Rajasthan.</p>

(iii)	Transfer of Students pursuing MVSc in Surgery and Radiology at CVAS, Navania (Udaipur) to CVAS, Bikaner	<p>With the permission of Chair, this agenda was raised by Faculty Chairman and Dean, CVAS, Bikaner. At present there are 4 students who are pursuing their PG in the Department of Surgery and Radiology. But there is no permanent teaching faculty member there. Out of four, one student has already completed his course work, completed research work and even delivered the thesis seminar also. He is about to submit the thesis. But, the other MVSc final year student has not yet started his research work. Two students are in MVSc (Previous). The House discussed the agenda and its gravity at length and took a serious view of the situation in view of larger interests of students, Considering the future of students, it was resolved to</p>

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		transfer the remaining three students who are pursuing MVSc in Surgery and Radiology at CVAS, Navania (Udaipur) to CVAS, Bikaner. The House also resolved that it should not be quoted as precedence in future in view of the exceptional circumstance which had arisen due to transfer of eligible guide without making any alternative arrangement. Thus, this should be considered as an 'Exceptional Case' for such a decision.
(iv)	Term 'Boys Fund' be replaced with 'Students' Fund'	With the permission of Chair, Dean, CVAS, Navania (Udaipur) informed the House that many a times a difficulty is being felt with regard to using the term 'Boys Fund' available with the constituent' colleges because this fund also includes the share of girl students. The House resolved to replace the term 'Boys Fund' with 'Student's Fund'.
(v)	Differences in the nomenclature of the new College of Dairy and Food Technology as well as of College of Dairy Science and Technology	Dean, CDFT, Bassi, Jaipur Dr. D.S. Meena informed the House that there are differences in the nomenclature of new Dairy and Food Technology as well as of College of Dairy Science and Technology as compared to the other such colleges in other universities. Matter was discussed at length and it was unanimously resolved to refer the matter to Government of Rajasthan for revised notification while ensuring uniformity in the names of colleges and also degree's awarded in view of 5th

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	Deans' Committee of ICAR.
