



Minutes of the 13th meeting of the Academic Council held on 17th December, 2018 at 11.00 AM in the Meeting Hall of VC Secretariat, RAJUVAS, Bikaner

The 13th meeting of the Academic Council was held on 17th December, 2018 at 11.00 AM in the Meeting Hall of V.C. Secretariat, RAJUVAS, Bikaner under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.

The list of Members as well as Invitees present in the meeting has been enclosed as Annexure-1.

At the outset, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor extended welcome to external member of the Council Dr. Ravindra Singh, Former Director, LUVAS, Hisar as well as all the members including representing Government nominees in the meeting. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor also highlighted on the draft Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations of RAJUVAS prepared under the Provisions of section 42, 44 and 46 of the Act. The House was told that the draft statutes have been prepared by the OSD to VC and discussed twice in the meetings of University officers. Later on, the same were uploaded on the University website www.rajuvas.org for obtaining suggestions from public. Suggestions emerged from the meetings of University officers as well as received from outside university through emails have been taken in to consideration in the Draft. It has been tried to get maximum reference from the established Universities/Institutions like with regards to Service Rules Swami Keshwanand Rajasthan Agricultural University, Bikaner, Government of Rajasthan, Recruitment and Selection Rules, University Grants Commission/ICAR as amended from time to time and as per the Rajasthan Universities Teachers & Officers (Selection for Appointment) Act, 1974 as amended and Rules of Veterinary Council of India

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor further told the House that over and above, some of the recommendations and suggestions have been taken into account. We have already discussed about the same and incorporated in the Draft. After approving the Draft by the Council, the same will be put up in the ensuring meeting of Board of Management going to be held on 18th

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December, 2018, Later on, the Draft will be sent to the Hon'ble Chancellor of the Universities, Rajasthan, Raj Bhawan for his assent further needful.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor stressed to provide quality of education in the colleges. For this, instructions have been issued and it is expected from the faculty that the same are being followed in letter and spirit by the concerned units/officers. If there is any difficulty, they may discuss with University authorities as well as in the House. This council can make structural arrangements, provide various procedures to be followed. I hope that instructions issued being the Chairman of this Council, Heads of academic institutions particularly the concerned Deans shall follow the same *in toto*. He also told that although there is paucity of time and they are overburdened, however, it should be our mandate to provide quality education to the students which is also our ultimate purpose. In near future, the University is going to plan to get suggestions within the University as well as from outside for starting diploma and short term courses for the students, under Skill Development Programme, may be on SFS basis so that they can start their own business, entrepreneurs and able to run their livelihood in future. These diploma courses may be of subject skills or out of the subject skills.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor appraised the House about the projects submitted recently to ICAR under NAHEP and it is hoped that the same will be approved in near future. He also briefed on the seminars recently organized at different campuses of the University particularly the National Symposium organized at Navania Campus. He told that although some facilities were established there, but the college show-cased its teaching, research and extension activities very well.
