



**Minutes of the 15<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council held on 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 at 11.00 AM in the Meeting Hall of VC Secretariat, RAJUVAS, Bikaner**

The 15<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council was held on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020 at 11.00AM in the Meeting Hall of VC Secretariat RAJUVAS, Bikaner under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof. Vishnu Sharma.

The list of Members as well as Invitees present in the meeting has been enclosed in Annexure-1.

At the outset Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Vishnu Sharma extended welcome to external members of the council Dr. Ravindra Sharma, Former Director Research, Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (LUVAS), Hissar (Haryana) and Dr.R.K.Bagherwal, Deptt. of Veterinary Medicine, College of Veterinary and Animal Science and Animal Husbandry, Mahu (MP) as well as members and invitees in the meeting.

Hon,ble Vice Chancellor appraised the council about the salient achievements made by the university after the last Academic Council Meeting-

1. A new Veterinary College at Jodhpur was announced by the Hon'ble Chief Minister in his budget speech. In this new college the land allotment is in final stage and government has sanctioned 41 posts of staff.
2. University has been awarded 12B category by UGC.
3. Veterinary college at Navania, Udaipur has been recognized by VCI and at PGIVER, Jaipur, the VCI team has been inspected recently.
4. In NIRF ranking RAJUVAS ranked first in the state.
5. In ICAR Ranking, RAJUVAS has been placed at no. 42 among all the SAUs of the country and II<sup>nd</sup> in State Agricultural Universities. Among all the 13 veterinary universities, RAJUVAS ranked at 6<sup>th</sup> position.
6. Last year an international training of Bangladesh veterinary officers was conducted by the university.
7. University has started e-bulletin especially for the veterinary students and it was appreciated widely.
8. A new VUTRC was started at Jhunjhunu.
9. Total 10 projects were sanctioned under RKVY "RAFTAR" with 4 ongoing projects and 6 new projects.
10. A orientation programme of 21 days was arranged for the newly recruited 100 Assistant Professors which will help in their personal promotion.
11. RAJUVAS entered in MoU with many national institutes and private organizations.



12. MOU with recognized prestigious institute ILRI and NCU, Poland is in process.
13. Since RAJUVAS is celebrating Decade Year, therefore, new initiatives have been taken. A milk parlour has been started at University main campus which will supply indigenous cow milk and its products. Similarly, milk parlour was started at Navania, In Jaipur Campus soon it will start.
14. An IPR cell has been established in the university. Services of Patent councillor/Consultant/Advocate will be hired/ empanelled by the university so that patent applications could be processed.
15. University intends to make all of the farms self dependent regarding mineral mixture requirement initially and then feed processing also.
16. University intends to produce organic livestock products and it will be certified by the recognized agency. The process of certification/authentication has been initiated.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor desired that one should have the passion for academics and for maintaining the quality of education, Deans are directed to take surprise visit in the classrooms and arrange seminars by the faculty. They are also instructed to establish central instrumentation facility for the benefit of the researchers. The list of the instruments available in the university has been uploaded to the university website and some of the laboratories of various colleges will be accredited by NABL in near future. The Deans are also directed to start publishing college magazines on regular basis and digitization of library should be taken on priority basis in all campuses.

Looking to the present need of the hour, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor informed the house that university has taken initiative in establishing cell on Livestock Innovation, knowledge and entrepreneurship skill (LIKES) in each college for the students who are looking their career as Entrepreneur. Director (Ext Edu.) must ensure the effective working of these cells. University is also planning for regular and formal linkage between RAJUVAS and Animal Husbandry/ Dairy, Fisheries and other line departments so that the research programmes and then the results and other development activities, initiatives can be shown to the government department and also university scientists can have an idea about the future research on the basis of requirement of farmer/ veterinary officer/ govt. functionaries. Such exchange forum will effectively deliver university services with the society. The house unanimously welcomed and appreciated such initiative.

Matter of attending conference/symposium/workshop etc. at abroad by the faculty was discussed at length. It was resolved to permit maximum three scientists in a year providing financial help partially for promoting their exposure abroad. A committee will be constituted with the approval of the Vice Chancellor who will work



out other modalities after collecting information from other universities in this context. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor also informed the house that the University is planning to utilise solar energy by installing more solar panel in all the campuses.
