विश्वविद्यालय के प्रबंध बोर्ड की नवम बैठक दिनांक 21 जनवरी, 2013 का कार्यवाही विवरण

09/ए	<p>विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा अब तक की गई प्रगति का संक्षिप्त विवरण मौखिक रूप से कुलपति द्वारा सदन में पेश। माननीय कुलपति ने सभी सदस्यों का स्वागत करते हुए विश्वविद्यालय की प्रगति से सभी सदस्यों को अवगत कराया।</p> <p>कुलपति प्रो. गहलोत ने बताया कि आगामी वर्ष के लिए विश्वविद्यालय के विकास की योजना तैयार है तथा राज्य सरकार से वेटेनरी विश्वविद्यालय के लिए राज्य आयोजना मद में लगभग 50 करोड़ की राशि के बजट का प्रावधान किया गया है। इस वर्ष में पांच जिलों में से राज्य का पहला वेटेनरी विश्वविद्यालय शिक्षा व अनुसंधान संस्थान बाकोलिया, लाडनू में खोला जायेगा तथा अगले वर्ष भी अन्य पांच जिलों में यह केन्द्र खोले जायेंगे। विश्वविद्यालय को अगले तीन वर्षों में सभी जिलों में वी.यू. टी. आर. सी. खोलने की योजना को भी सरकार ने स्वीकृत कर दिया है। कुलपति प्रो. गहलोत ने बताया कि पशु चिकित्सा संस्थानों से निकलने वाले पशु जैव चिकित्सीय अपशिष्ट के निस्तारण की प्रक्रिया तथा विधि तय करने के लिए एक केन्द्र स्थापित करने की मन्जूरी राज्य सरकार ने प्रदान कर दी है। वेटेनरी अपशिष्ट के निस्तारण के तरीके खोजने के लिए वेटेनरी विश्वविद्यालय, बीकानेर देश का प्रथम केन्द्र होगा। वेटेनरी विश्वविद्यालय के बीकानेर आकाशवाणी से जुड़ने एवं इस गतिविधि को पशुपालकों द्वारा प्रभावी रूप से अपनाने का देखते हुए पूरे राज्य में इसका विस्तार करने की भी योजना है और राज्य के सभी आकाशवाणी केन्द्रों द्वारा वेटेनरी विश्वविद्यालय के कार्यक्रम "धोर्णों से बातें" को प्रसारित किया जा सकेगा। कुलपति प्रो. गहलोत ने बताया कि विश्वविद्यालय ने कर्मचारी कल्याण योजना के तहत 26 सेवानिवृत्ति कर्मचारियों को उनके अंशदान का भुगतान कर दिया गया है तथा पांच दिवंगत कर्मचारियों के वारिसों को एक लाख रुपये का भुगतान भी इस योजना से कर दिया गया है। कुलपति प्रो. गहलोत ने बताया कि राज्य सरकार द्वारा मेरिट सूची में आने वाले विद्यार्थियों को लेपटॉप प्रदान किये जाने की योजना में वेटेनरी विश्वविद्यालय भी जुड़ गया है। अगले वर्ष से यहां के मेरिट में आने वाले छात्र-छात्राओं को भी राज्य सरकार लेपटॉप प्रदान करेगी। कुलपति महोदय ने यह भी बताया कि विश्वविद्यालय में एक समग्र कोष (एन्डोवमेन्ट फण्ड) के रूप में कारपस फण्ड की स्थापना को मन्जूरी मिलने के साथ ही यह राज्य का पहला विश्वविद्यालय हो गया, जिसमें इस तरह की कोष की स्थापना हम करने जा रहे हैं। इस कोष</p>

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	<p>में पशु चिकित्सा के क्षेत्र में विकास हेतु वेटेनरी विश्वविद्यालय के पूर्व छात्र, अधिकारी, सामाजिक संस्थाएं, स्वयंसेवी संस्थाएं या उद्योग राशि प्रदान कर सकते हैं। इस कोष में राज्य सरकार द्वारा प्राप्त कारपस फण्ड भी डाला जायेगा। विश्वविद्यालय भी अपनी आमदनी का हिस्सा इस कोष में जमा करा सकता है। इस समय कोष का उपयोग पशु चिकित्सा सेवाओं में वृद्धि हेतु किया जायेगा तथा कर्मचारी व विद्यार्थी कल्याणार्थ किया जायेगा। कुलपति ने बताया कि विश्वविद्यालय ने रिक्त स्वीकृत पदों की भर्ती हेतु प्रारम्भिक तैयारियां लगभग पूर्ण कर ली हैं तथा शीघ्र ही विज्ञापन जारी कर ऑनलाइन आवेदन पत्र मांगे जायेंगे।</p>



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Annexure-2

Qualifications for direct recruitment on the posts of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor in the Faculty of Veterinary & Animal Sciences.

FACULTY OF VETERINARY AND ANIMAL SCIENCES

PROFESSOR

1. An eminent scholar with recognized basic veterinary qualification, unless otherwise required and prescribed, and Ph.D. in the concerned/ allied/ relevant discipline and published work of high quality, activity engaged in research with evidence for published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/ or research/ policy papers.
2. A minimum of 10 years of teaching/ research/ extension education experience, of which at least three years should have been spent as Associate professor or equivalent position in an equivalent pay scale in University/college and/ or National Level Institutions/Industries including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
3. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal system (PBAS) set out in University Regulation termed as 'Score Card for Professors'.

Or

An outstanding professional with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR

1. Good academic record with recognized basic Veterinary qualification, unless otherwise required and prescribed, and a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline.
2. A minimum of 8 years of experience in teaching/ research and/ or extension education in a position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University/College or equivalent position in a university/ College or Research Institution/Government/Semi-Government Institutions/Departments on the posts having equivalent pay scale (excluding the period spent in Ph.D. research subject to a maximum of 3 years) with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/ or research/ policy papers.

3. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) set out in University Regulation termed as 'Score Card for Associate Professors'.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR

1. A basic Veterinary qualification, unless otherwise required and prescribed, and Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade of 6.5/10.0 or 3.2/4.0 in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
2. For the candidates having Master's degree, NET/SET shall remain compulsory (subject to condition provided at serial number three below) along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment for the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines, where NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work, as prescribed UGC Regulations 2009, and candidate has at least two full length publications having a NAAS rating of not less than 4, on the last date of the submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
3. Looking to scarcity of qualified human resource in many disciplines of Veterinary and Animal Science, a candidate having proficiency and requisite qualifications, but is yet to clear NET/SET, his/her candidature shall be considered and if found suitable and selected, he/she shall have to pass NET/SET within a period of three years of the appointment, failing which his/her appointment shall be terminated without notice. No further extension will be given to fulfil aforesaid conditions.

- In service candidates of RAJUVAS having post graduate degree of M.Sc.(Ag.) in Dairy Husbandry/Animal husbandry & Animal Science/Animal Production with a degree of B.Sc.(Ag.) shall also be eligible for recruitment in the disciplines of LPM/LPT/Animal Nutrition/Animal genetics & Breeding.

- In the subjects of Veterinary Biotechnology, Veterinary Biochemistry and Livestock product technology, post graduates in relevant fields, not having a degree of M.V.Sc., will also be eligible




CRITERIA FOR AWARD OF GOLD MEDAL IN UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMME


1. The student who has secured highest OGPA shall be eligible for gold medal. If more than one student secure same highest OGPA then all such students shall be eligible for gold medal.
2. Student should not have ever failed or got compartment/supplementary during the course of study.
3. Student should not have been put on conduct probation or convicted by any Court of Law during the course of study.
4. Student should have completed his degree in stipulated period.
5. The University reserves the right not to award gold medal without assigning any reason.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD OF GOLD MEDALS IN POST GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMMES

1. The student who has secured highest OGPA in each post-graduate degree programme shall be eligible for gold medal provided his OGPA is 8.0 or above in 10.0 point scale. If more than one student secure same highest OGPA then all such students shall be eligible for gold medal. Further, there shall be no condition of minimum number of students in each post graduate degree programme.
2. Student should not have ever failed/awarded unsatisfactory grade (US) during the course of study.
3. Student should not have been put on conduct probation or convicted by any Court of Law during the course of study.
4. Student should have completed all the requirements including submission of theses for degree in stipulated minimum period (four semesters in case of Masters' degree and six semesters in case of doctoral degree).
5. The University reserves the right not to award gold medal without assigning any reason.

RAJUVAS ENDOWMENT FUND (REF)

The Board in exercise of the powers vested in it under Section 12 (2) (c) and as per the provisions of Section 35 (a) of the Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences Act, 2010 approves in its 9th Meeting held on 21st January, 2013, creation of a fund to be known as the **Rajuvas Endowment Fund** herein after may be referred to as REF, in the interest of the University as well as in larger public interest, as follows:

Objectives

1. To create a separate corpus fund through contributions:
Explanation: The State as well as Central Government through the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), the State etc. is continuously enhancing the financial aid to the Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Bikaner but the funds received from these as well as other funding agencies are not sufficient to conduct research and development to meet the challenges that are ever emerging in the State. Continuous efforts are being made by the University to enhance its resources through new projects as well as generating more income from various means at its disposal to meet out the financial requirement of the University at its own. For this purpose, the Board has decided to create a corpus fund to be termed as the Rajuvas Endowment Fund for which efforts will be made to get financial aid from Faculty/ Alumni of the University/ Philanthropists/ Indian Companies and other agencies/ institutions/ individuals who are willing to serve the cause the University and are willing to provide aid in the shape of donations/ contributors etc.
2. Intensification of research, development and welfare efforts:
Explanation: Though, Rajasthan has achieved very high level of animal productivity, yet we need more intensive and continued research and development efforts are required in the field of animal husbandry. The financial aid being received through various sources falls far short of the requirement. Under such circumstances, the University should make earnest efforts to raise additional funds to meet its objectives. The donations/ contributions so received will be invested and/ or utilized on the wisdom of the Fund Management Committee (FMC) on Research, Teaching and Extension education or any such purpose falling within the purview of the interest of the University, its staff, students and public at large.

Rules for the operation of RAJUVAS Endowment Fund

1. Definitions:

- i. 'Cashier' means Cashier in the office of Comptroller or any other person(s) authorized by the Comptroller, RAJUVAS, Bikaner to receive and disburse the payment and to maintain the accounts of REF.
 - ii. 'Competent Authority or CA' means the Vice-Chancellor, RAJUVAS,
 - iii. 'Contribution' means any fund received from Donors.
 - iv. 'Controlling Officer or CO' means the Comptroller, RAJUVAS, Bikaner or any other official nominated by the Competent Authority for the purpose. 'Donor' means Faculty/ Staff/ Alumni of the University/ Philanthropists/ Indian Companies/ Firms/ Contractors/ other agencies/ institutions/ Individuals/ any other source donating / contributing to REF.
 - v. 'Drawing & Disbursing Officer' means the Head of Department or any other person to whom the operation of REF fund's account may be authorised by the CA.
 - vi. 'Fund or REF' means RAJUVAS Endowment Fund.
 - vii. 'Fund Management Committee or FMC' means the Committee (Not less than 4 members including the Chairman) of Senior Officers of the University formed by the CA with CA being the Chairman and the Comptroller as the Member Secretary framed by the CA for the purpose of managing the Funds in a prescribed manner.
 - viii. 'Pre-audit' means the audit in the manner prescribed (by the FMC) by the Auditors of the RAJUVAS, or Comptroller or authorized (by the FMC) person(s)/ official(s) of the RAJUVAS for this purpose.
 - ix. 'Prescribed' means as prescribed by FMC.
2. All the money meant for the REF will be received by the CO on the consent of the CA and duly acknowledged.
 3. Contributions from the donors, others than University staff, shall be received in REF in multiples of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One thousand only).
 4. Contributions from the University Staff may also be deductible from their salary, in the installments as desired by them.
 5. The Board of Management of the RAJUVAS may also direct, from

- time to time, transfer of funds accrued as income of the University (by whatever means) to REF in accordance to the Section 12 (2) (c).
6. The State or Central Government or any of its department/ agency/ unit/ undertaking shall also be permitted to contribute, may be with the conditions, as may be prescribed.
 7. The CO shall be responsible for maintaining REF accounts with utmost transparency.
 8. The allocation from the Fund will be made by the CO as sanctioned by the CA.
 9. Money received from Faculty/ Staff/ Alumni of the University/ Philanthropists/ Indian Companies/ Firms/ Contractors/ other agencies/ institutions/ Individuals/ any other source will be utilized and / or invested in beneficial schemes/ deposits/ securities by the CO on the approval of the FMC which may be constituted by the CA.
 10. REF could also be utilizable by diverting any size of part of REF to University's Employee Welfare Scheme (s) (by whatever name) or any other fund/ scheme of the University, provided that the FMC foresees growth in such diversions or provided that there is sufficient scope of doing so.
 11. REF can also be used for advancing loans for any purpose related to the University on the interest rate as prescribed and deemed fit by the FMC.
 12. The REF shall be utilizable as per orders of the CA for strengthening of facilities in Research, Teaching and Extension education as well as for welfare of RAJUVAS staff and students.
 13. The expenditure out of this Fund will be allowed to be utilized as per prescribed/ approved procedure by the FMC.
 14. The University shall ever endeavor to grow this fund.
 15. A separate bank account will be maintained for the operation of REF which will be operated by the DDO designated for this purpose.
 16. The payments from this Fund will be made after pre-audit.
 17. The Comptroller will prepare Balance Sheet of the REF at the end of each financial year which will be put up to the Board of Management after the same has been considered by the Finance Committee of RAJUVAS.
 18. The CA will be competent to relax or to amend any rule(s), to interpret these rules and to issue clarification for the smooth operation of the Fund. Any modification, however, shall be

- reported to FMC.
19. CA, CO and FMC shall not be held responsible for not attaining foreseen gains or forecasted growth of the REF, and no action shall be institutionable against them.
 20. Similarly, no action of CA, CO and FMC or any person related to fund handling or management taken by following prescribed procedures and in good faith shall be challengeable in any manner.
 21. Any grievance or dispute in respect to REF shall be filed or reported or raised to the Vice-Chancellor, who shall convey, after getting it examined, his/ her decision to the grieved party, which shall be final. All such cases shall be reported to the FMC.
 22. Donors shall not have any right to guide the way of management of REF in their own interest. Nevertheless, this clause shall not restrict any person(s) involved in REF management from donating. Such person (s) shall also not be excludable from managing REF.
 23. Funds once contributed to REF by donors (other than the University or the Government) shall be non-refundable under any circumstances and donors shall loose all rights over the contribution made to REF.
 24. Contributions from the donors pursuing business or commerce shall be part of their corporate social responsibilities and willful as well as self-motivated attempt to help the cause of the University. Such donors should not expect as well as shall not be provided any benefit or favour from the University, individually, collectively, to the firm or company or trust or society, whatever the case is, in any of its business dealings with the University on account of their being a donor. However, they shall be free to participate in any competitive bid or contract fairly without expecting any favour from the University.
