### Minutes of the Sixth Meeting of Academic Council (held on 25<sup>th</sup> March., 2013)

- 1. The sixth meeting of Academic Council of the Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Bikaner was held on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2013 at Conference Hall of ABG Department, CVAS, Bikaner under the Chairmanship of Prof. (Dr.) Col. A.K. Gahlot, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.

- 3. In the opening remarks, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor welcomed all the members. He appraised the House about the progress of the University pertaining to financial as well as academic sector. The members were appraised about the financial grants received under RKVY i.e. Rs. 2.00 crores and from ICAR i.e. Rs. 1.50 crores, totalling to Rs. 8.58 crores.
- 4. The House also appraised about the proposals submitted to ICAR for grant under TSP, viz., (i) Establishment of Advanced Training Centre in the Field of Animal Husbandry (ii) Mobile Ambulatory and Mobile Diagnostic Services for Tribal Area in Southern Districts of Rajasthan and (iii) Production and Dissemination of Preservation Technologies of Important Fodder to Youth and Farm Women of Tribal Area of Southern Rajasthan. It was further apprised the House that under Tribal Sub-Plan (TSP) Rs. 120.00 lac for the purpose of strengthening of training hub, audio-visual lab, clinics as well as fodder farms of Navania campus will be received soon by the University.
- 5. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor also appraised the House about the progress of recruitment to be undertaken in near future for projects sanctioned to this University under 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan.
- 6. The House was also appraised of about the visit of a Micro-Mission of the World Bank led by Ms. Helen Lietch, Livestock Advisor and her appreciation of entrepreneurship programmes. During discussions, she was apprised of the Practical Manuals. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor expected from the House that such more entrepreneurship should be developed every year for students in different disciplines.
