

**RAJASTHAN UNIVERSITY OF VETERINARY & ANIMAL SCIENCES, BIKANER****Minutes of the Fifth Meeting of Academic Council held on 6th December., 2012**

The Fifth Meeting of Academic Council of Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Bikaner was held on 6th December, 2012 at Conference Hall of ABG Department, CVAS, Bikaner under the Chairmanship of Prof. (Dr.) Col. A.K. Gahlot, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor. The list of participants is as per Annexure-1.

In the opening remarks, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor welcomed the new members namely Dr. Rakesh Rao as Registrar and Dr. T.K. Gahlot as Director-Clinics, who attended the Academic Council meeting in their present positions for the first time. The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor also appraised the house that the Government of Rajasthan has sanctioned total 405 posts to this University after its establishment, which will add great strength to the existing disciplines as well as the University would be able to create new disciplines having scientific man power in the relevant fields. Probably with these strengths, in so many disciplines, this University will be only of its kind in the country. He emphasized that now the recruitment process has to be geared up and therefore many of the Agenda Items are pertaining to fulfil legal formalities regarding various posts. He also emphasized that with so many posts being sanctioned by the State Government and total budget of around Rs. 520 crore in the 12th Five Year Plan likely to be streamed through the State Government, the expectations of the State Government as well as the sector have become very high. The University requires to gear up to provide better human resource and service for upliftment of the sector in the state. After these remarks, the house took up agenda items put up by the Registrar.

Agenda No. 05/C:-	To consider approving qualification for the direct recruitment on the posts of Officers and Teacher & Non-Teaching posts	The table of qualification for direct recruitment of officers and non-teaching posts has been revised by the Council after thorough discussion which is enclosed at Annexure-III. These qualifications, which were approved earlier by the BOM, are required to be revised in light of the Rajasthan Universities Teachers and Officers (Selection for appointment) Act, 1974 as Act restricts promotion on posts which are of the cadre of Assistant Registrar and above. Therefore, the qualifications for direct recruitment against these posts have been proposed and were discussed in light of the fact that now there will be no opportunity for in-service lower cadres to be promoted on these posts. Therefore, the qualifications need to be tuned according to the qualifications held by the lower cadres which have been proposed to be considered for these posts.
