

# Minutes of the 10<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council held on 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 at 11.00 AM in the Meeting Hall of VC Secretariat, RAJUVAS, Bikaner

The 10<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council was held on 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 at 11.00 AM in the Meeting Hall of V.C. Secretariat, RAJUVAS, Bikaner under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.

The list of Members as well as Invitees present in the meeting has been enclosed as Annexure-1.

At the outset, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor extended warm welcome to all the members of the Academic Council, specially of the newly inducted members who are attending their first meeting particularly the Registrar Sh. B.R. Meena, RAS as well as newly nominated members of the Academic Council.

While briefing the House about the achievements as well as activities, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor highlighted that significant progress has been made by RAJUVAS in Academics. We have strengthened our 4-tear of formal education with Diploma, Degree, Post-graduation and Ph.D. in all the campuses in almost full-fledged manner. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor also pointed out that our Navania as well as PGIVER campuses are required to be strengthened more by way of strengthening Master's and Ph.D. programmes in time to come subject to availability of facilities and faculty. Apart from this, he also pointed out that RAJUVAS is also strengthening its education system by way of providing trainings to farmers through skill development programmes. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor also informed the House about the IEAC Report of RAJUVAS comprising details of teaching, research, extension activities as well as other administrative aspects. He also informed the House that on the basis of the Self Study report and inspection, the University as well as College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner have been accredited by ICAR. With regard to CVAS, Navania and PGIVER, Jaipur, the Accreditation Committee recommended that let the first batches come out, then, the University can apply for accreditation of these two institutions. He also informed the House that on the basis of this accreditation, the University got first instalment of its Development and Strengthening grant from ICAR of more than Rs. 5.0 crore initially. He also informed that from this year, for implementing MSVE, 2016, without any hastle, we will implement the same in letter and spirit. He further appraised the house about the directives of Hon'ble Governor with regard to Marking System, establishment of Chancellor's Gold Medal, and to strengthen the training and skill development of faculty through making a roster. With regard to these directions of Hon'ble Governor, he apprised the House that we are already having system of Committee of Courses as well as Board of Studies to look into the matter of reviewing the syllabus and, time and



again, we are doing it. But, now with these directions, we will have to form a Syllabus Review Committee which may work round the year. With regard to CBCS and CFSD of UGC, we have already taken steps.

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor also informed the house about recent visit of Hon'ble Chief Minister at Livestock Research Station, Dug, Jhalawar on 16<sup>th</sup> of December, 2016 where she remained for around 1 hour 45 minutes and we could get not only the opportunity to show-case Malvi Cattle Breeding farm and its activities, but also, apprise her our Animal Husbandry Diploma Programme started recently. The Hon'ble C.M. also interacted with the students. *Bhoomi Poojan* was also undertaken by Hon'ble C.M. at our farm and she praised RAJUVAS for its different activities. Therefore, it may be concluded that our University is progressing in right direction and the State Administration as well as State Government machinery is happy with it and also realises its progress.

The House deliberated in detail the directives from the Hon'ble Governor to form a Syllabus Review Committee which can recommend the updation of syllabi at regular intervals consisting atleast 2 external members. After deliberations, it was revealed that the University has a system of Committee of Courses in each disciplines which includes atleast 2 external experts of the discipline concerned. Therefore, the House resolved that the Committee of Courses should be redesignated and shall work as the Syllabus Review Committee for that particular discipline. The recommendations of the Syllabus Review Committee shall be considered by the Board of Studies of the Faculty. The House further desired that the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor may inform about formation of Syllabus Review Committees to the Hon'ble Governor's Secretariat. The House further desired that the meeting Syllabus Review Committees should be conducted at least twice a year and with mandatory presence of external members.
Agenda No.10/13:	To develop a roster for training of teachers.	The House discussed in detail the directions of the Hon'ble Governor suggesting that all the teachers should be sent for regular trainings and skill upgradation. The House decided that Chairman Faculty should compile details about the teachers who have undergone any kind of skill upgradation training in the form of short course winter/ summer school/ refresher course of journal and subject specific nature during last 5 years, and also prepare a roster for next five years for the teachers to undergone atleast 2 such trainings. The House further observed that in case of Universities and Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, there are probably no Academic



Staff College exists in the country. Therefore, the faculty can be sent for orientation or refresher course to the institutions which are frequently organizing such courses pertaining to the disciplines of teachers.

#### Agenda No.10/14:

To consider granting clarification on the following points sought by the Scrutiny Committee constituted vide University order dated 20.06.2015 for screening of the application received in response to the University Advertisement No. RAJUVAS/2015-01-01 to 2015-01-06 dated 18.05.2015 which shall be helpful in scrutiny of applications updated from above advertisement and/or fresh applications received in response to advertisement of 2017.

After thorough discussion, the House resolved the following:

- 1. i) The phrase 'Veterinary Public Health' is mandatorily required to be included while considering the equivalence of the qualification.
  - While deciding the equivalence of ii) Master's Degree in Livestock Production and Management, the phrase 'Production and Management' should be considered as keyword, whereas, the word 'Livestock' may be replaced only by the word 'Animal' or 'Dairy'. Poultry sciences should not be equated with the disciplines of Livestock Production and Management for the post in the discipline of Livestock Production and Management. However, the House made it clear that in the discipline of Poultry Science, the candidates having Master's in Livestock Production and Management shall be considered as has been advertised.
  - iii) While drawing the equivalence of Master's Degree in Animal Biotechnology, the words 'Animal Biotechnology' should remain the key words.
- 2. As has been provided in the Application Form for the post of Professor, Major Advisor, Co-Advisory Member as well as Member of Advisory Committee, both are to be considered, and separate marks have been provided for both in case of number of



student(s) who have completed their Ph.D. degree. However, for the post of Professor, if the applicant is currently guiding Doctoral Research as Major Advisor or Co-Advisor/Member of Advisory Committee whose students have yet to complete the Ph.D. Degree should be considered as evidence of guiding the Doctoral Research for the purpose of deciding eligibility.

3. For the candidates working in private sector/institutes, experience shall be given credit in score card only if the certificate from respective private sector/institution is produced and if the Unit is registered one or if the Management/Society is registered under the respective Act. Further more, employees of line departments of State Government having served in GP 6000 or above should also be counted as experience as has been practiced earlier in Assoc. Professor and prescribed for Assoc. Professor in new Advertisement also.

The House further approved the directives issued vide Notifications No. F.( )/ RAJUVAS/Reg /R&P/2013/183 dated 26.07/05.08.2013 and Order No. F. ( )/ RAJUVAS/Reg/R&P/2014/271 15.02.2014 and above clarifications shall be in addition to the clarifications issued vide above mentioned Notification and order. However, the last date of application shall be considered as applicable with respect to the current Advertisement instead of 21.03.2013 as mentioned in the above referred order.
