It gives me immense pleasure to share you that Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Bikaner has been awarded by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan State with "e-Governance Rajasthan Award 2019" in "Rajasthan Innovation Meet" ceremony organized by Government of Rajasthan. The University also got 42nd rank in ICAR Ranking-2018 amongst all the Agricultural and Veterinary Universities of the



country. RAJUVAS has also secured second place amongst all the Agricultural Universities of the Rajasthan State. I am happy to mention that Hon'ble Chief Minister of Raiasthan Sh. Ashok Gahlot in State budget presented on 10 July, 2019, has announced establishment of new veterinary college at Jodhpur. Further, financial sanction of 41 posts has also been accorded by the government.

During this quarter, third convocation of the University was organized on 8th August, 2019. Total 433 students were awarded B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree, 198 students received M.V.Sc. degree, 38 students conferred Ph.D. degree, 31 students received gold medals and 1 student was awarded with Chancellor Gold Medal. For providing the excellent diagnostic and treatment facilities to farmers community and livestock owners a Super Specialty Block was inaugurated at Surgery and Radiology Department of CVAS, Bikaner that is equipped with different facilities including units of CT scan, sonography, laparoscopy, laser surgery, ophthalmology, orthopedic and dental care. I wish to convey my thanks to Govt. of Rajasthan for believing on conducive work, environment and efficiency of RAJUVAS and approved a grant of Rs. 11.95 crore for the year 2019-20 under the Rastriya Krishi Vikas Yojna "RAFTAR" to this University.
