कुलपति की कलम से

हम सौभाग्यशाली हैं कि माननीय राज्यपाल एवं राजुवास के कुलाधिपति श्री कल्याण सिंह जी ने 15 से 17 सितम्बर, 2015 तक अपने तीन दिवसीय बीकानेर प्रवास में राजुवास के विभिन्न कार्यक्रमों में शिरकत कर हमें आशीर्वाद दिया। अपने प्रवास के पहले दिन 15 सितम्बर 2015 को माननीय राज्यपाल ने राजुवास के पहले तकनीकी म्युजियम का लोकार्पण किया और ई-शासन के एकीकृत विश्वविद्यालय प्रबंधन केन्द्र का उद्घाटन व छात्राओं के लिए नए छात्रावास की नई विंग की आधारशिला रखी। माननीय कुलाधिपति ने इन कार्यक्रमों के अंत में पत्रकारों से रूब-रू होते हुए वेटेरनरी विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा अपनी स्थापना के अल्पकाल में अर्जित उपलब्धियों की सराहना करते हुए विश्वविद्यालय की हौसला-अफजाई की। इस अवसर पर उनके प्रकट किए गए उद्गारों का उल्लेख करना चाहूंगा। वेटेरनरी विश्वविद्यालय ने कम समय में उच्च शिक्षा को आधुनिक तकनीक से चलाने के कदम उठाए हैं। मैं, राजुवास के कुलपति प्रो. ए.के. गहलोट के कामकाज से बहुत प्रसन्न हूँ जिन्होंने अभूतपूर्व कार्य कर

विश्वविद्यालय के प्रथम दीक्षांत समारोह का आयोजन

1127 उपाधियां व 57 छात्र-छात्राओं को स्वर्ण पदकों से नवाजा गया

माननीय राज्यपाल एवं राजुवास के कुलाधिपति श्री कल्याण सिंह ने 16 सितम्बर को राजस्थान पशुचिकित्सा एवं पशु विज्ञान विश्वविद्यालय के प्रथम दीक्षांत समारोह में पशुचिकित्सा एवं पशु विज्ञान की 1127 उपाधियां प्रदान कर 57 छात्र-छात्राओं को स्वर्ण पदकों से नवाजा। 917 स्नातक, 199 स्नातकोत्तर और 11 विद्यार्थियों को विद्या-वाचस्पति की उपाधियां प्रदान की गई। विश्वविद्यालय परिसर में सेना बैंड की स्वरलहरियों के बीच दीक्षांत शोभा यात्रा के पंडाल में प्रवेश के बाद कुलाधिपति की अनुमति से दीक्षांत समारोह शुरू हुआ। दीक्षांत समारोह की अध्यक्षता करते हुए माननीय राज्यपाल एवं कुलाधिपति ने अपने संबोधन में कहा कि दीक्षांत एक ऐतिहासिक अवसर होता है जिसके पीछे विश्वविद्यालय का सपना, प्रतिबद्धता, नवाचार के साथ शिक्षकों, कर्मचारियों व विद्यार्थियों की कड़ी मेहनत होती है। डिग्रियां प्राप्त करने वाले विद्यार्थी राज्य के साथ ही राष्ट्र के लिए एक महत्वपूर्ण मानव संसाधन हैं। भारत एक ऋषि और कृषि प्रधान देश है। कृषि और पशुपालन का गहरा संबंध है जो किसान की जिंदगी और मौत से जुड़ा है। राज्य के लगभग 70 प्रतिशत ग्रामीण परिवारों की आय का साधन पशुपालन है अतः पशुचिकित्सक सेवा भाव को लेकर अपने कार्य क्षेत्र में जाएं और पशुपालकों के लिए कार्य करें। यह विश्वविद्यालय पशुपालन के क्षेत्र में विकास के लिए अनुसंधान और प्रसार का कार्य तीव्र गति से कर रहा है। उन्होंने वेटेनरी विश्वविद्यालय के ई-मॉडल के लिए सभी को बधाई देते हुए कहा कि यह एक आदर्श प्रयास है जिसे राज्य के सभी विश्वविद्यालयों को लागू करना चाहिए। माननीय राज्यपाल ने कहा कि कृषक देश का उत्पादक और बड़ा उपभोक्ता भी है अतः कृषकों की आर्थिक स्थिति में सुधार जरूरी है। अतिवृष्टि, ओलावृष्टि, अनावृष्टि, ओला-पाला और खेतिहर रोगों से कृषक को बचाने के लिए उसकी फसलों और पशुओं का बीमा करवाया जाना चाहिए। कुलपति प्रो. ए.के. गहलोत ने दीक्षांत समारोह को सम्बोधित करते हुए कहा कि राजुवास अपनी स्थापना के अल्पकाल में शैक्षणिक, अनुसंधान और प्रसार शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में पशुचिकित्सा में आधुनिक तकनीक और कार्यप्रणाली का समावेश करके आगे बढ़ रहा है। मुख्य अतिथि भारतीय कृषि अनुसंधान परिषद के उपमहानिदेशक (कृषि शिक्षा) डॉ. एन.एस. राठौड़ ने अपने दीक्षांत भाषण में कहा कि पशुचिकित्सा क्षेत्र में कार्य करने की विपुल संभावनाएं मौजूद हैं। विश्वविद्यालय से निकलने वाले छात्र के जीवन में 4-टी ट्रेडिशन (परंपराओं से), टेक्नोलॉजी (तकनीक), टेलेन्ट (हुनर) और ट्रेनिंग (प्रशिक्षण) का विशेष महत्व है। अब आपको अंतिम टी तक पहुँचकर पशुपालकों और कृषकों की सेवा करनी है। डॉ. राठौड़ ने कहा कि देश के 73 राज्य कृषि विश्वविद्यालयों में अपने कार्यों और दूरदर्शिता से आगे बढ़ते हुए राजुवास ने अग्रणी स्थान बनाया है। दीक्षांत समारोह में मुख्य अतिथि के रूप में भारतीय पशुचिकित्सा परिषद, नई दिल्ली के अध्यक्ष डॉ. उमेश चन्द्र शर्मा ने नव दीक्षित पशुचिकित्सा छात्रों का आह्वान किया कि समाज के पिछड़े

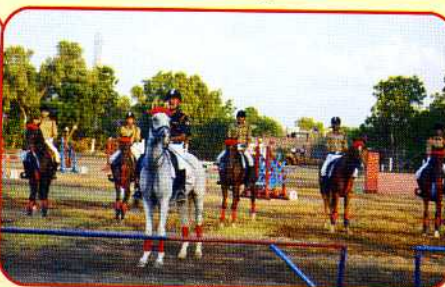




और कमजोर वर्ग को पशुपालन से ऊपर जाने के लिए काम करें। खेती में मुनाफे के लिए पशुपालन महत्वपूर्ण है अतः इसके लिए कार्य कर कृषकों की पीड़ा को कम करने के लिए अपना योगदान दें। दीक्षांत समारोह में विशिष्ट अतिथि राज्यपाल के विशेषाधिकारी श्री अजय शंकर पाण्डे शामिल हुए। दीक्षांत समारोह को विश्वविद्यालय की वेबसाइट पर सीधा प्रसारित किया गया जिसे देश-विदेश में बैठे लोगों ने भी देखा। समारोह स्थल पर भी एल.ई.डी. की बड़ी स्क्रीन पर दीक्षांत समारोह का सीधा प्रसारण किया गया। दीक्षान्त समारोह में विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा प्रकाशित मुख्य प्रकाशनों का विमोचन भी अतिथियों द्वारा किया गया। दीक्षांत समारोह में डॉ. बी.आर. छीपा, कुलपति एस.के.आर.ए.यू. डॉ. चन्द्रकला पंडिया, कुलपति, एम.जी.एस.यू., विश्वविद्यालय की प्रथम महिला श्रीमती अरुणा गहलोत, आर्मी जी.ओ.सी. मेजर जनरल जे.के. शर्मा, प्रबन्ध मंडल एवं अकादमिक परिषद् के सदस्य, शहर के गणमान्य नागरिक व प्रशासन के उच्चाधिकारी उपस्थित थे।

विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा गोद लिए डाइयां ग्रामवासियों से रूब-रू हुए राज्यपाल

राज्यपाल एवं कुलाधिपति माननीय श्री कल्याण सिंह ने नाल ग्राम पंचायत के डाइयां गांव का 17 सितम्बर, 2015 को दौरा किया और वहां आयोजित पशुपालक सम्मेलन में ग्राम वासियों से रूब-रू हुए। वेटरनरी विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा गोद लिए गए 'डाइया' को एक आर्दश गांव के रूप में विकसित किया जा रहा है। राज्यपाल एवं कुलाधिपति ने सम्मेलन को सम्बोधित करते हुए कहा कि शिक्षा जरूरी है अतः हर एक बेटा और बेटी को पढ़ाने से ही तरक्की की राह खुलेगी और हम दुनिया की दौड़ में आगे बढ़ पाएंगे। उन्होंने कहा कि वे स्वयं गांव के और किसान के बेटे हैं अतः यहां आकर उन्हें अपनत्व महसूस होता है। राज्य के सभी विश्वविद्यालयों को एक-एक गांव गोद लेने के निर्देश दिये गए हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि ग्रामीणों द्वारा बताई गई समस्याओं का निराकरण करवाया जाएगा। जिला स्तर की समस्याएं दर्ज की गई हैं। राज्य स्तर पर समाधान होने वाली समस्याओं के निराकरण के लिए भी वे निर्देश देंगे। इससे पूर्व राज्यपाल ने ग्राम वासियों से एक-एक कर उनकी समस्याएं सुनी। उन्होंने ग्रामीणों से ही गांव में शिक्षा, चिकित्सा, बिजली, पानी, सड़क, परिवहन, पशुओं की संख्या और उत्पादन, शौचालयों की स्थिति तथा ग्रामीणों के जीवन स्तर के बारे में सभी जानकारियां प्राप्त की। माननीय कुलाधिपति ने आशा जताई कि वेटरनरी विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा गोद लिए डाइयां गांव में कुलपति प्रो. ए.के. गहलोत की दूरदर्शिता और नेतृत्व क्षमता से यहां भी बदलाव महसूस किया जाएगा। पशुपालक सम्मेलन में विशिष्ट अतिथि के रूप में शामिल पूर्व सिचाई मंत्री श्री देवी सिंह भाटी ने कहा कि गांवों में शून्य खर्च आधारित अर्थव्यवस्था में पशुधन, गोचर, ओरण का खास महत्व रहा है। जनसहभागिता से ही योजनाओं और नए अनुसंधान की उपादेयता हो सकती है। गांवों को स्वावलम्बी बनाकर ही विकास पथ पर बढ़ा जा सकता है। कुलपति प्रो. ए.के. गहलोत ने स्वागत भाषण में कहा कि



विश्वविद्यालय योजनाबद्ध तरीके से डाइयाँ को एक आदर्श गांव बनाएगा जो दूसरों के लिए प्रेरणादायी होगा। ग्रामीणों ने माननीय राज्यपाल और पूर्व सिचाई मंत्री को साफा पहनाकर, शॉल, श्रीफल भेंट कर सम्मानित किया। पंचायत समिति की प्रधान राधा देवी सियाग ने कहा कि अब डाइयाँ गांव का भाग्योदय हो रहा है। नाल गांव की सरपंच सुनीता सुराणा ने धन्यवाद ज्ञापित किया। इस अवसर पर माननीय राज्यपाल के विशेषाधिकारी अजय शंकर पाण्डे, जिला कलेक्टर पूनम, जिला पुलिस अधीक्षक संतोष कुमार चालके सहित जनप्रतिनिधिगण और गणमान्य लोग उपस्थित थे। इस अवसर पर माननीय राज्यपाल ने विश्वविद्यालय के प्रसार शिक्षा निदेशालय द्वारा आयोजित प्रदर्शनी का उद्घाटन किया। प्रदर्शनी में विश्वविद्यालय की गतिविधियों और अनुसंधान को चित्रों, पैनल, मॉडल के रूप में प्रदर्शित किया गया।

पशु चारे से सम्बन्धित उद्योगों की राज्य में अपार सम्भावनाएँ : मुख्यमंत्री श्रीमती वसुन्धरा राजे

मुख्यमंत्री श्रीमती वसुन्धरा राजे ने कहा है कि राजस्थान में पशुधन का विकास सरकार की प्राथमिकता है, क्योंकि विपरीत भौगोलिक परिस्थितियों में भी राज्य की कृषि अर्थव्यवस्था को पशुधन ही निरन्तर गति देता है। मुख्यमंत्री 10 सितम्बर, 2015 को कंपाउंड लाइव स्टॉक फीड मैनुफैक्चरर्स एसोसिएशन (सीएलएफएमए) ऑफ इंडिया के जयपुर में वार्षिक समारोह का उद्घाटन कर रही थीं। मुख्यमंत्री ने कहा कि राजस्थान देश के सबसे बड़े पशुपालक राज्यों में एक है, लेकिन यहां पशु चारे की सख्त कमी और सूखे के दिनों में तो यह कमी और भी बढ़ जाती है, इसलिए राज्य में पशुचारे से संबंधित उद्योगों की अपार सम्भावनाएं हैं। इसी प्रकार पॉल्ट्री फीड के लिए आवश्यक मक्का का राजस्थान में उत्पादन प्रचुर मात्रा में होता है। मिश्रित पशुआहार के लिए कच्चा माल भी यहां अच्छी मात्रा में उपलब्ध है, क्योंकि सोरगम, बाजरा, दालें व गेहूं जैसे सभी जरूरी अनाज की प्रदेश में अच्छी पैदावार है। उन्होंने उद्यमियों और निवेशकों का आह्वान किया कि वे प्रदेश में पौष्टिक पशु आहार के उत्पादन, इससे जुड़ी मशीनरी एवं अन्य व्यवसायों में निवेश करें। श्रीमती राजे ने कहा कि कृषि क्षेत्र में निवेश को प्रोत्साहन देने के लिए राज्य सरकार एक कृषि प्रसंस्करण एवं कृषि विपणन नीति तैयार कर रही है, जिसका लाभ भी पशु आहार उद्योग में निवेश करने वाले उद्यमियों को मिल सकेगा। मुख्य अतिथि श्रीमती वसुन्धरा राजे ने वेटरनरी विश्वविद्यालय में इस ओर किए जा रहे अनुसंधान का जिक्र करते हुए कहा कि पशुधन आहार की गुणवत्ता और पौष्टिकता से ही उत्पादन अधिक लिया जा सकता है। उन्होंने विशेष तौर पर वर्ष पर्यन्त हरे चारे की उपलब्धता के लिए हाइड्रोपोनिक्स तकनीक का जिक्र किया। उल्लेखनीय है कि वेटरनरी विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा हाइड्रोपोनिक्स तकनीक के तीन केन्द्र स्थापित कर इस पर अनुसंधान कार्य किया जा रहा है। मुख्यमंत्री श्रीमती राजे ने पशु आहार के उत्पादन उद्योगों के प्रतिनिधियों को आह्वान किया कि वे वेटरनरी विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा स्वदेशी गौवंश संवर्द्धन के प्रयासों और पशुधन चारा एवं आहार प्रबन्धन क्षेत्र में किए जा रहे अनुसंधान और उपयोगी कार्यों के लिए तकनीकी जानकारी प्राप्त कर सकते हैं। उन्होंने गौवंश की विलुप्त हो रही स्वदेशी नस्लों यथा विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा किये गए साहीवाल नस्ल के संवर्द्धन उपायों की प्रशंसा की। राज्य के पशुपालन एवं कृषि मंत्री श्री प्रभुलाल सैनी ने कहा कि राजस्थान में 5.77 करोड़ से अधिक पशुधन है और देश का 11.62 प्रतिशत दूध का उत्पादन हमारे यहां होता है। इसके चलते यहां पशुधन के विकास के लिए आवश्यक मिश्रित पशु आहार उत्पादन उद्योग के विकास की अपार सम्भावनाएं हैं। मुख्य सचिव श्री सी.एस. राजन एवं वेटरनरी विश्वविद्यालय के कुलपति प्रो. ए.के. गहलोत ने भी इस सम्मेलन में शिरकत की। कुलपति प्रो. गहलोत ने राज्य में पशुधन विकास हेतु मुख्यमंत्री का आभार व्यक्त किया।

Animal Health Camp in Adopted Village

Department of Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Extension Education and Teaching Veterinary Clinical Complex, CVAS, Bikaner jointly organized an animal health camp in University adopted village Daiyan on 10th September, 2015. Director Clinics Prof. T.K. Gahlot constituted a team of 16 experts from all clinical departments. In this camp, 185 animals were treated. Among them 29 cases of surgery, 51 cases of Veterinary Obstetrics & Gynaecology and 85 cases of medicine were treated. Mineral mixture was distributed to about 200 livestock owners. Deworming of 3000 animals was also done. Dr. Neeraj Sharma Assistant Professor was the Coordinator of this camp.



School Students Visited Biodiversity and Fodder Museum

The Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI) and RAJUVAS have entered into an agreement to undertake the study titled, Addressing Bovine Tuberculosis at the Human-Animal Interface and Veterinary Antibiotic Use in Small Holder Peri-Urban Dairy Farms in India to Ensure Safe and Sustainable Milk Production.
