From Vice-Chancellor's Desk

Dear Readers,



Our university has been recognized one of the leading Institutions of the State to uplift the livelihood of the farmers associated with livestock, dairy and fisheries sector. RAJUVAS has been witnessing decade year and during this year I am happy to mention that University has started many new initiatives to serve the cause of livestock owners, students, society and veterinary fraternity of the State. In order to develop awareness about importance of Indigenous cow's milk and milk products in the society, Indigenous Cow's Milk and Milk Products Parlour will be started in every constituent colleges of the University. Participation of students will be ensured for skill development and self-employment. In order to provide an opportunity for veterinary students for innovation and start-up, Livestock Innovation, Knowledge and Entrepreneurship Skill (LIKES) Cell will be established in all the three

constituents' colleges of the university. Similarly, there is also a plan to start Add-on Certificate Course on specific topics for Veterinary students. This innovation will not only result in all round development of students but also their personality and skill development. The university has so far done research and innovation in various fields which need to be patented. A solid beginning will be made to patent them in this decade year. Further, there is a need to take concrete steps for the MOU with International institutions. In this decade year, concerted efforts will be made to manufacture animal feed and mineral mixture at the University's Livestock Research Stations at their own level so that the university does not have to depend on the purchase from outside and the livestock farm can move towards self-sufficiency. Several high-end and state-of-the-art laboratories have been established at the RAJUVAS, but NABL accreditation of these state-of-the-art laboratories is required to be done so that the capacity of these laboratories is developed and commercial benefits can also be obtained.

Presently, special emphasis is being given on organic animal production in the state and it is being suggested by the Raj Bhavan also to take it on priority. Under this initiative, the university will also try to bring Livestock Research Farms to the organic mode in a systematic and time bound manner so that the availability of organic livestock products can be made. For the all round development of the state's animal husbandry, the university will work as a platform to connect with other departments related to animal husbandry such as animal husbandry, dairy, fisheries. In this decade year, the services of disease diagnosis and milk quality testing facilities will be made more effectively at the VUTRCS established in different districts of the Rajasthan. RAJUVAS will adopt one Gaushala in different districts of the state through VUTRCs to provide technical guidance to each gaushala and convert it into model gaushala for others. Looking to the unawareness about the veterinary profession in students of rural and urban areas, the university through its units will organize veterinary education awareness programmes so that the secondary and higher secondary schools students is aware of this important field of veterinary and animal husbandry and could adopt as carrier.

None of this is possible without the generous support of farming and scientific community along with State Government that can play a key role in financial support to university for this noble vision.

I wish you all a very Happy New Year 2020.

Early Diagnosis of Avian Botulism by RAJUVAS Team in Migratory Birds

Saved the Large Numbers of Migratory Birds at Sambhar Lake (Jaipur)

In the first week of November 2019, a severe disease outbreak in the birds which migrated from various parts of the world to Sambhar Lake (Jaipur) and nearby areas was reported in the news papers and various TV channels. The outbreak was reported to kill thousands of

the migratory birds. A team from RAJUVAS led by Prof. A.K. Kataria, Officer Incharge, Apex centre was sent by Prof. Vishnu Sharma, Vice-chancellor, RAJUVAS, Bikaner to investigate the disease. On the basis of history, epidemiological observations, classical clinical symptoms and post-mortem findings, diagnosis was made on the spot right at the time of visit as Avian Botulism. The recommendations were given to the concerned authorities to control the mortality included immediate removal of carcasses from the area, deep burial/burning of carcasses in order to stop eating of carcasses by healthy birds, development of rescue centre at affected site, strict monitoring of operations and any fresh mortality etc. under the guidance of Dr. Dinesh Jain, PI, LFRMTC fortified feed was prepared for migrated birds and distributed to Rescue Centre, Sambhar, Jaipur. RAJUVAS team diagnosis was later confirmed by IVRI, Izatnagar (Bareilly). The recommendations given to administrations, concerned authorities and general public were followed strictly and the mortality in the migratory birds was completely stopped within next 4-5 days.
