From Vice-Chancellor's Desk


Dear Readers,

The year 2013 was an eventful year in which RAJUVAS marched ahead leaps and bounds with the zealous support of entire RAJUVAS fraternity. I take this opportunity to thank them all and hope same fervor and zeal in 2014. Animal husbandry is the mainstay of rural economy in Rajasthan, contributing 10.21% to the GDP of the State, which is more than 50% of the contribution of total agriculture sector (including animal husbandry). In this desert abound state, where rain is mostly unpredicted and insufficient to crop based regular agriculture, livestock/poultry rearing keeps the household fuel burning and the economy of the farmer running. Animal husbandry sector has greatest potential for rural self-employment.

Rajasthan is second largest State in milk production contributing >11% of country's total milk. It contributes 30% meat (mainly from sheep and goat) and 38% of wool production of the country. Animal husbandry sector revolves an economy of whopping Rs. 125000 Crore around it every year in the State. It is the only segment of Agriculture which is keeping a consistently higher growth rate as >5%.

Since its inception, RAJUVAS is all set to catalyze Animal husbandry sector of the state through teaching, research and extension activities with a strategy to outreach each animal owner of the state. At RAJUVAS we have opened newer frontiers in veterinary research through establishment of several cutting edge technology centres. Focus is now on ethno veterinary practice and alternative medicines, Livestock feed and fodder resource, wildlife health and management, disaster management in animals, organic animal production, use of space based technologies in animal sciences, animal bio-medical waste disposal, conservation of animal biodiversity, nuclear medicine etc. We are also strengthening disease diagnosis tools using biotechnology, disease forecasting, ambulatory clinical and diagnostic services and enhancement in quality milk production through breed improvement. While research will lead to development of newer technologies, our KVK(s) & training and research centres (VUTRCs) at each district will be the outreach kiosks for every animal owner/farmer of the state. All these are tough challenges but it is rightly said, "Challenges are what makes life interesting and overcoming them is what makes it meaningful". We at RAJUVAS are committed to every goal through our own efforts and also through linkages with other national and international organization. "There is no elevator to success. You have to take the stairs, one step at a time". Great things are done by a series of small things brought together.

Dear Readers, I take this opportunity to express my warm wishes for a very happy, fruitful and prosperous new year 2014 for you all.

Activities

Emergency Ward for Heat Stroke Cases

The ward will keep inside temperature between 22-26°C when outside temperature is 40-50°C which predisposes animals to heat stroke. Foundation Stone-Laying Ceremony of New Building of PGI-VER, Jaipur

Foundation Stone-Laying Ceremony of new building for Post Graduate Institute of Veterinary Education and Research (PGI-VER) was conducted on 3rd October, 2013 at Jamdoli, Jaipur. The Govt of Rajasthan has allocated 18.9 acre land for this Institute. This Institute is a constituent college of RAJUVAS, Bikaner and is second in the country for post graduation in Veterinary Sciences. The Chief Guest of the function was Dr. Rajesh Maan, Director, Dept. of Animal Husbandry, GOR. A total of 75 crore rupee will be incurred on construction of building, hostels and other research facilities in the 12th five year plan. Vice-Chancellor Prof. A.K. These veterinary executives shall be placed at Milk chilling centres across eight districts (Jaipur, Ajmer, Tonk, Sikar, Pali, Nagaur, Bhilwara, Dausa) of Rajasthan on the package of Rs. three lacs per annum.
