# **University Activities**

## **Fifth Convocation of RAJUVAS**

The fifth convocation of the RAJUVAS was held on 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 in the university's auditorium. Hon'ble Governor of Rajasthan and Chancellor Shri Kalraj Mishra joined the convocation through online mode and presided over the function. Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture and Animal Husbandry Sh. Lalchand Kataria and Deputy Director General (Agriculture Education), ICAR, New Delhi Dr. Rakesh Chandra Agrawal was special guests of the convocation. Prof. A.K.
