Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered on the day 13th July, 2020

Between

THE UNIVERSITY OF TRANS-DISCIPLINARY HEALTH SCIENCES AND TECHNOLOGY (also known as Trans-Disciplinary University), a State Private University established by The Institute of Trans-Disciplinary Health Sciences and Technology Act, 2013 (Karnataka Act No: 35 of 2013 & amended Karnataka Act No: 13 of 2018) vide notification number HFW 90 PTD 2013, issued by the Government of Karnataka, represented by Registrar with its offices at 74/2, Jarakabande Kaval, Yelahanka, via Attur post, Bengaluru 560064, hereinafter referred to as "TDU", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include it's successors and permitted assigns as the FIRST PARTY,

and

RAJASTHAN UNIVERSITY OF VETERINARY & ANIMAL SCIENCES, established under the Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences Act, 2010 (Act No. 13 of 2010) and having its headquarters at Bikaner and with assigned jurisdiction of whole of the Rajasthan State (hereinafter referred to as RAJUVAS) and called the Second Party with a dedicated mandate of teaching, research and extension in veterinary and allied subjects.

WHEREAS,

TDU, whose primary mandate is the creation of new Trans-Disciplinary / multidisciplinary / interdisciplinary knowledge in traditional health sciences, basic sciences, clinical, pharmacological, pharmaceutical, biomedicine, life sciences, environment studies, design architecture, performing and fine arts, engineering, technology, management and social sciences.

- Affordable, accessible and scalable solutions for unmet social needs
- Original knowledge contributions arising from interface of Traditional Knowledge and Modern Science.

AND WHEREAS,

"RAJUVAS" is a Premier University actively involved in veterinary education, research, and extension having jurisdiction all over the State of Rajasthan through its constituent colleges, research & extension units and affiliated colleges.

NOW THEREFORE, "TDU" & "RAJUVAS" inspired by their common interest in contemporary societal applications arising out of the use of medicinal plants and traditional knowledge for veterinary care agree to collaborate in order to promote and accelerate the progress in the areas spelt out under article

Both parties have decided to enter into this MoU and agree as herein contained:

ARTICLE I

General Conditions

- 1.1 Both institutions subscribe to the policy of equal opportunity and will not discriminate on the basis of gender, age, disability, race, colour, region, marital status, veteran's status national or ethnic origin or sexual orientation.
- 1.2 The output in the form of any new invention or product or equipment or industrial design or process and publication etc. in the form of patent, copyright, industrial design, geographical indicator registry etc. arising out of joint efforts/ research will be shared by both the institutions in proportion to their respective contribution as mutually agreed in principle before and as assessed on completion of the joint project.

- 1.3 The travelling expenses of the visiting students and academic staff who are visiting the institution will be met as mutually agreed. The logistic support and hospitality expenses will be met by host institution for them, wherever it is necessary.
- 1.4 If the service of an expert identified as the resource person from either of institutions is required, the travel and logistic support has to be borne by the Institution inviting the resource person.
- 1.5 Exchange of faculty for guiding the research programs on traditional medicine and animal health will be carried out as mutually agreed.
- 1.6 The progress of all specific projects to which this Memorandum of Understanding may lead to, shall be evaluated on a regular basis by a small coordination committee, designated by authorities of both institutions.
- 1.7 For conditions of the linkage and terms of understanding not covered by this Memorandum of Understanding or for problems which arise while the exchange agreement is in effect, both parties agree to refrain from unilateral action and to consult with each other and to negotiate for mutually agreeable decisions.

The Memorandum of Understanding has been drawn on the following terms and conditions:

ARTICLE II

- 2.1 TDU has laboratories, databases, herbarium, experience in community based clinical studies and challenges at the interface areas of Science and Ayurveda. TDU has scientists who have expertise in the specific areas of research, training and extension.
- 2.2 Similarly, **RAJUVAS** has a team of trained manpower and state of art laboratories, facilitating basic and applied research.

ARTICLE III

Generally agreed that TDU &RAJUVAS will collaborate on

- 3.1 Research in areas of mutual interest such as pharmacology, standardization, clinical studies, social acceptance and any other area, related to herbal medicine for Ethno- Veterinary practices & Veterinary Ayurveda for veterinary applications.
- 3.2 Conducting certificate/ diploma/ joint degree programmes for veterinarians, para vets, rural community, NGO, CBOs and faculty members.
- 3.3 Conducting joint programmes such as conferences, seminar, symposia, training and workshop etc at National/ International levels on mutually agreeable terms.
- 3.4 Mutual sharing information required for the purpose of research in the area of Ethnoveterinary practices & Veterinary Ayurveda.
- 3.5 Any other project/ program mutually agreed upon.

ARTICLE IV

4.1 The MoU between two institutions may be supplemented by detailed work plans to be developed jointly which describe more specifically the activities to be carried out under this collaborative programme.

ARTICLE V

This understanding shall be in effect initially for a period of 5 (five) years from the date of last signature and may be automatically renewed thereafter unless mutually decided either party may terminate the MOU by written notification sent to the proper officer of the institution. Such notice must be received by either party three months prior to the effective termination date. However, no such termination shall adversely affect any continuing program/ research and / or project under this MOU for its completion.
