Indian agriculture is typically characterized by an essential symbiosis of crop and livestock production. Animal husbandry sector substantially contributes to social, economical and nutritional security of rural masses. As per Basic Animal Husbandry Statistics-2023, total milk production in India was 230.58 million tons during 2022-23. Milk production has increased by 3.83 % over the previous year's (2021-22) production. Rajasthan is highest milk producing state in country with almost 14.44 percent share in total country milk production in 2022-23. The Gross Value Added of livestock sector is about 30.47 % of agricultural and allied sectors GVA. On-farm value addition activity offers an alternative for diversification and rural development. In response to the global progress in agricultural production, many farmers have turned to participate in value-added activities of agricultural crops to ensure their survival in the intense competition in the global markets. RAJUVAS has taken innovative steps for promoting maximum utilization of cow dung and urine with proper processing and utilizing these as fertilizer as well as pesticides at farmers' fields.
