## Academic Activities

### National Conference of ISVPT

23<sup>rd</sup> National Conference of Indian Society of Veterinary Pharmacology and Toxicology on the theme Integrated animal health care system: opportunities and challenges was organized by CVAS, Bikaner from 2-4 November, 2023. Vice-Chancellor, DUVASU, Mathura Prof. A.K. Srivastava as Chief Guest said that this conference is being organized with the aim of taking proper care of the health of animals and increasing productivity in the country. He said that healthy livestock and good production play an important role in supplying nutritious food to the people and this is the responsibility of the veterinary community. Presiding over the function, Vice-Chancellor RAJUVAS, Bikaner Prof. Satish K. Garg emphasized that 70 percent of the livestock in the country is with small and marginal farmers; hence we need research on alternative medicine to reduce the cost of animal health and treatment. We have to give emphasis to research on ayurvedic and homeopathic medicine systems along with allopathic medicine. Prof. Garg said that there is immense employment potential in veterinary sector and we have to promote inter-institute, inter-disciplinary and inter-industry affiliations along with quality research. Guest of Honour Prof. Vinod Kumar Verma Vice-Chancellor, LUVAS, Hisar told that today veterinarians will have to pay attention to the usefulness of rational quantities of drugs in the treatment of animals. Researcher need to pay more attention to high quality research in pharmacokinetic and pharmacodynamics. Vice-Chancellor of Rajasthan Ayurved University, Jodhpur, Prof. Pradeep Kumar Prajapati said that by maintaining the ecosystem, the life span of livestock and humans can be increased. Former Vice-Chancellor RAJUVAS Prof. A.K. Gahlot in his address said that there is a need to study veterinary, ayurvedic and homeopathic medicines in "One Health Mission". Referring to the new challenges in the field of pharmacology and toxicology, he expressed the need for proper use of IT, communication, nanotechnology, AI, stem cell technology along with traditional knowledge. ISVPT Chairman Dr. A.M. Thakar presented the annual progress report of the society. At the beginning of the conference, the Dean Prof. A.P. Singh delivered the welcome address. Organizing Secretary Dr. Pratistha Sharma expressed gratitude to everyone. On this occasion compendium and ISVPT E-Bulletin was also released. Total 175 subject matter experts-scientists from across the country participated in the national conference and presented research paper and posters.

#### CVAS, Bikaner

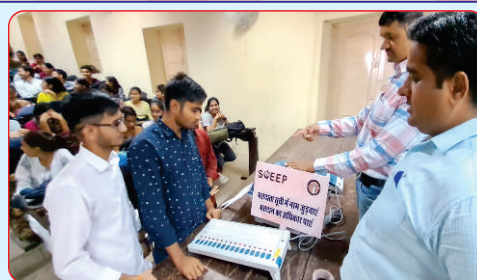

#### CVAS, Navania (Udaipur)

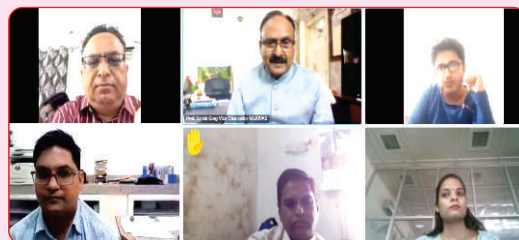
