The city was founded in the late 15th century by Rao Bikaji, a Rajput prince, and is named after him. The city is also known for its intricately carved temples, such as the Karni Mata Temple, which is famous for its large population of rats, and Laxmi Nath Temple, built in 15th century and is dedicated to Lord Vishnu. Bikaner is also home to several historic forts, palaces and havelies, including the Junagarh Fort, which was built during the 16 century and houses several palaces and temples within its walls. The city is also known for its handicrafts, particularly its Usta-art, leatherwork, and carpets. Today, the city is thriving on its rich cultural heritage, supply of sweets, namkeens and attracts visitors from all over the world who come to explore its history, culture, and cuisines.

Call for Abstracts

Submissions are invited for individual animal clinical studies in the fields of Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Wild & Zoo Animals, Avian, Camelids and Equine. Clinical case reports, studies, or findings must be relevant to the subjects of the technical sessions. The research studies will not be accepted for this conference.

Submission Guidelines

- * Pre-registration of presenting author is compulsory
- * Abstract: All abstracts must adhere to the following formatting requirements:
 - i) Font: Times New Roman
 - ii) Size: 12
 - iii) Spacing: 1.5
 - iv) Word Limit: Maximum 250 words
- * Author Details: The presenting author must underline his/her name and include their Name, Email, and Mobile Number.
- * Submission Deadline: 31st March 2025

- * ii) Discussion: 2 minutes
