From Vice-Chancellor's Desk

Dear Readers.



Animals and human beings are socially, economically, culturally and religiously linked to each other, since ancient times. Veterinary profession is one of the noblest professions and dedicated in service of animals. Veterinarians treat all domestic and wild animals and birds and are therefore considered more knowledgeable and skilled. Livestock is one of the most important potential sectors from state economy perspective, especially rural economy. Potential of agricultural sector depends upon huge investments and weather conditions. But compared to agriculture, animal husbandry and livestock are more promising, stable and require lesser investments. Over the years, livestock and poultry have proved to be life saviour in many distress conditions, especially during drought. Milk, egg and meat production in India have show unprecedented growth mainly due to scientific technological interventions and India has been also ensure nutritional security of its huge population despite of climate change, scarcity of food and fodder, poor indigenous germplasm and animal welfare issues.

But huge livestock population is proving boon to the India specially, Rajasthan. Lot of emphasis has to be given on genetic improvement of indigenous breeds for improving their productivity using latest reproductive biotechnological tools on one hand and adopt preventive measures for prevention of zoonotic and other diseases especially FMD, brucellosis and mastitis etc. Livestock production system has to be driven by scientific knowledge coupled with use of artificial intelligence in managing our herds and flocks. Animal diseases significantly affect production and international trade of livestock products. Therefore, there is need to have a comprehensive and integrated disease surveillance and control programmes to ensure animal health, quality products of livestock origin for human consumption. One health approach can solve most of the problems associated with human, livestock and environment health. During the coming months, new academic session will start and University envisages to start the session 2023-24 by mid of September 2023. We thank ICAR for having sanctioned two winter schools of 21 days duration each and these will be organized during the months of December 2023 and February 2024.

It is matter of great pleasure that University is celebrating the "Platinum Jubilee Year" of College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Bikaner. During this year, University has planned to arranged "Platinum Jubilee Lecture Series" by inviting distinguished alumni of this college and also eminent Veterinary professionals from different professions for motivation of veterinary graduate and post graduate students. We also fore see recruitment of around 70 Assistant Professors in the coming months. With the likely appointment of teachers in the University, teaching and research activities will definitely improve.

Academic Activities
