

Round 4 will be offline round and candidates have to report physically at RAJUVAS Bikaner for counselling process

Frequently Asked Questions

(These are only for explanation purpose of the process and if any ambiguity arises in FAQs and Information Booklet or any other official document of University then the things mentioned in Information Booklet or allotment letter or as decided by University authority will be the final and things mentioned in FAQs will not have any legal existence and will be considered as null and void)

Q. No. 1: Is it necessary to report physically of Round 1 allotted seat to get chance to participate in Round 2?

Ans: Yes, candidates have to report at RAJUVAS Bikaner and have to deposit fee of Round 1 allotted seat.

However, if you want to upgrade in round 2, give up-gradation willingness for Round 2 after completing the formalities of admission for allotted college at RAJUVAS, Bikaner.

Q. No. 2: If a candidate does not report during Round 1, whether he has to register again for Round 2 or 3?

Ans:- If candidate has been allotted college in Round 1 and he fails to report in person at RAJUVAS, Bikaner for admission formalities and fee deposition, then his admission will be cancelled and he will not be allowed to participate in further online rounds. No fresh registration will be allowed in any case, and he will not be allowed to participate in further Rounds.

Q. No. 3: Who are not eligible for next Rounds of allotment?

Ans:- (a) Candidate who has become non-eligible due to having inadequate documents as per Eligibility Criteria.

(b) Who have been allotted college in any round but did not report physically after seat allotment in Round 1 or Round 2.

Q. No. 4: Can I modify my choices after first round of allotment

Ans: No, you can not modify, add or delete your choices during this period. However, the fresh registration will be permitted only in offline round and you will be able to modify your choice.

Q. No. 5: How can I get print out of my choices which system has locked?

Ans: As per schedule after locking of choices by the system, you will be able to take a printout of your submitted choices after login using your login ID and password on the portal. You will also be able to see your locked choices and able to take a print out of the same at the time of admission on request.

Q. No. 6: If I opt to participate in second/third round of counseling whether my allotted seat (of previous round) will be cancelled?

Ans: In case you are not allotted any seat in the second round, you will retain your earlier allotted seat in Round 1. Similarly, in case you are not allotted any seat in the third round, you will retain

earlier allotted seat in Round 1 or 2. However on up- gradation of a seat in second round or third round, the earlier allotted seat in First Round or Second Round respectively will automatically be cancelled and allotted to another candidate. You will also have **NO claim** over the earlier seat and have to report physically at RAJUVAS, Bikaner on specified date and time as per counselling schedule for admission formalities on newly allotted college seat.

Q. No. 7: If I get an up-graded seat during a subsequent round, can I join that college directly?

Ans: **No**, you will have to report at RAJUVAS, Bikaner only after every round of allotment, if there is change in your previously allotted seat. After finalizing all rounds of counselling or start of classes only, you have to report in the finally admitted college.

Q. No. 8: In case I get an upgraded seat but in the same college, because of change of category, (e.g. from SC or ST to UR category) do I have to take admission on the allotted seat again?

Ans: Yes, you have to physically report at RAJUVAS, Bikaner; otherwise your seat will be cancelled and allotted to another candidate.

Q. No. 9:- What is the procedure for Counseling which will be conducted offline?

Ans. The net vacant seats due to non-joining or non-reporting upto Round 3 will be published in the seat matrix and eligible candidates. Fresh on spot registrations will be allowed for this round.

Q. No. 10: Is it necessary to join allotted College of Round 1 or 2 or 3?

Ans: No, candidates have to report at RAJUVAS Bikaner only and you need not to report in allotted college unless you are finally advised to do so by admission board of RAJUVAS, Bikaner.

O. No. 11: How I have to deposit my fee for allotted college?

Ans:- If you have been allotted any college in any round then you have to report physically on the date and time mentioned in your allotment letter at RAJUVAS, Bikaner only. You can deposit fee in the form of Demand Draft (tuition fee decided for allotted college i.e. Rs 3 Lakhs for constituent colleges and Rs 5 Lakhs for private veterinary colleges) in the name of "Comptroller Fees Collection RAJUVAS Bikaner" and rest of regular fee of constituent colleges and difference amount of tuition fee for private colleges may be deposited cash or via online mode as mentioned in the fee structure of respective college. All the fee will be deposited at RAJUVAS, Bikaner only not in allotted college.

Q. No. 12: I have been allotted college in Round 1 but I donot want to take admission and wishes to upgrade. Will I be allowed free exit for Round 1 allotted college?

Ans:- No, you must have to report at RAJUVAS, Bikaner on specified date in person for admission formalities and have to deposit required fee for allotted college. Then only you will be allowed to submit upgradation request for next round.

There will be no free exit in any Round like NEET (UG) counselling procedure.

Q. No. 13: Can I take admission in any choice of college?

Ans: No, you can only upgrade in subsequent rounds and in no case you will be allowed to downward choice college in any online round. However, you can modify your choices in offline round.

Q. No. 14: I have been allotted college in any Round and I had deposited fee also but in next round my seat type is modified or any other college is allotted to me. My previously deposited fee will be refunded or I have to deposit fee again?

Ans:- You have to deposit required fee for allotted college once. If you have been upgraded for free seat or your next allotted college fee is less then the previously allotted college, you need not to deposit the fee again and your difference amount will be refunded to you after completion of counselling. You have to submit written application for this mentioning your account details.

Q. No. 15: How I can participate in offline mop-up round?

Ans:- (a) If you have not been allotted any seat in any previous round then you have to register a fresh by paying requisite fee for Mop-Up round on the date notified on website.

(b) If you have been admitted already in any college during any round of college but you want to participate in Mop-Up round, then you have cancelled your admission by submitting written application for this before the display of vacant seat matrix for Mop-Up round. Your previously deposited admission fee may be refunded as per the UGC Rules specified for this purpose. After that only you will be allowed to register a fresh by paying requisite fee for Mop-Up round.

Q. No. 16: I have been allotted college in any Round. Now what documents I need to bring for admission?

Ans:- You have to bring all original documents for verification at the time of in person reporting at RAJUVAS, Bikaner on the date mentioned in allotment letter. You must bring one self attested photocopy set of all original documents. Your documents will be deposited at RAJUVAS, Bikaner. However, in any emergency you can get back your original documents by producing affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper.

Q. No. 17: I have been allotted college in any Round and I had deposited fee also. Now I don't want to participate in further rounds?

Ans:- If you have been admitted in any college and don't want to participate in further rounds of counselling then you need not to submit upgradation form and wait for the start of classes. Once the date of start of classes be announced and notified on the website, you have to report at the admitted college and start your studies.
